

US Congress from Illinois  
2016 Election Results

Although Illinois has historically been a Democratic state & voted for Hillary Clinton in the 2016 General Election, the US Congress from Illinois is made up of 2 Senators and 18 Representatives as follows:

2 Senators (Both Democrats)

- Richard Durbin (D) - Term 2014 - 2020
- Tammy Duckworth (D) – Term 2016 - 2022

NOTE: A Senator's term of office is six years. Approximately one-third of the total membership of the Senate is elected every two years.

18 Representatives (11 Democrats and 7 Republicans)

Note: Members of the House of Representatives serve two-year terms and are considered for re-election every even year.



2016 Election Results:

## senate results



## House of Representatives Race


Naperville residents are either in the 6<sup>th</sup> District (R) or the 11<sup>th</sup> District (D).

## house results




6<sup>th</sup> District (Northern Naperville): Peter Roskam (R) – Incumbent that won 65K more votes than his opponent.

11<sup>th</sup> District (Southern Naperville): Bill Foster (D) – Incumbent that won 58K more votes than his opponent.

10<sup>th</sup> District (Northeast Illinois): The only Illinois District to have a party change in 2016. The District went Red (R) to Blue (D).
